St. Vincent de Paul Louisville Campus Buildings

- **Administration Building – 1015-C S. Preston Street**
 - Administrative staff offices.
- **DePaul Apartments – 1015-A S. Preston Street**
 - 12 two-bedroom apartments for homeless families.
- **Family Success Center – 1029 S. Preston Street**
 - The Family Success Center offers the SVDP Drop-In Center, which is a safe space to help adults (male and female) navigate barriers to obtaining housing and employment.
- **Food Pantry – 415 E St Catherine Street**
 - The Food Pantry is 100% volunteer-run and is open every Tuesday and Thursday from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. Clients receive fresh produce, frozen meats, poultry, fish, and pantry staples.
- **East Family Apartments – 436 E. Kentucky Street**
 - 6 two-bedroom and 4 three-bedroom apartments, serving homeless families.
- **West Family Apartments – 416 E. Kentucky Street**
 - 6 two-bedroom and 4 three-bedroom apartments, serving homeless families.
- **Open Hand Kitchen – 1026 S. Jackson Street**
 - Community kitchen serving free meals for dinner at 5 p.m. every day of the year to anyone who walks through its doors.
- **Ozanam Inn Men's Emergency Shelter – 1034 S. Jackson Street**
 - Ozanam Inn is a 24/7 access site that provides emergency shelter and supportive services to single men 18 years or older, serving 60 individuals per night including 10 private rooms.
- **One Bedroom Apartments – 421 E. St Catherine Street**
 - 10 one-bedroom apartments for individuals and/or couples where one resident has a disability.
- **Simon Hall – 1022 S. Jackson Street**
 - Future additional staff building.
- **Tranquil House – 1035 S. Preston Street**
 - A site-based Section 8 Housing Assistance Payment program with 12 efficiency apartments for those with a chronic mental illness.
- **Transitional Housing – 431 E. St Catherine Street**
 - 18-units for those in need of housing and supportive services.
- **Waypoint House – 1041 S. Preston Street**
 - 24 single room occupancy units for homeless male or female Veterans.
