Notifying the Public of Rights under Title VI

- In addition to the complaint process at Society of St. Vincent de Paul, Council of Louisville, Inc. complaints may be filed directly with the Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, Region 4, 230 Peachtree Street, NW, Suite 1400, Atlanta, GA 30303
- 3. Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
- 4. The form must be signed and dated, and include your contact information.
